It has been brought to the notice of the Chairman, APSHE that some Law colleges are demanding for higher fees than fixed by the APHERMC and insisting on depositing of original certificates of the candidates.

In this regard, I am by direction, once again reiterated that, the institutions shall collect fee as prescribed by Andhra Pradesh Higher Education Regulatory and Monitoring Commission (APHERMC) and fixed by the Government of A.P. only. Any demand for higher fee is violation of the Government order and will be viewed very seriously.

It is also informed that the institutions shall verify the original certificates and return by retaining the photocopies of the certificates. The institutions shall not retain original certificates except transfer certificate.

In this regard, the principals are requested to follow the rules strictly in the admission process.
