The qualified and eligible candidates of AP LAW CET/ PG LAW CET-2024 examination who have not registered for the Phase-I counselling are informed to register and participate for AP LAW CET/ PG LAW CET-2024 **SECOND & FINAL PHASE** Web Counseling for admission into the First Year of 3 Year and 5 Year LLB/LLM Courses for the Academic Year 2024-2025 as per the time line given as under. The details of colleges, courses, seats & tuition fee and all other important information are placed on the **Website <https://cets.apsche.ap.gov.in>** Candidates are informed to visit this website before they go for Registration and Web options. Candidates are informed to upload their certificates at <https://cets.apsche.ap.gov.in> for verification.

***Candidates are informed that they should satisfy the eligibility criteria for admission under BCI Rules (may be seen for Legal Education Rules, 2008 official website of BCI <http://www.barcouncilofindia.org>), related State G.Os and should be prepared to pay the tuition fee and other fee as applicable.**

***This Notification itself is a call for counselling. No separate call letters will be sent to the individual candidates.**

***Mere attending Web counselling does not guarantee a seat.**

CERTIFICATES TO BE UPLOADED BY ALL CANDIDATES.

1. APLAWCET/APPGLCET-2024 Rank Card & Hall Ticket
2. Memorandum of marks of SSC or equivalent.
3. Memorandum of marks of Intermediate or equivalent.
4. Memorandum of marks in qualifying examination (Intermediate or its equivalent pass certificate for 5 year LLB course and Degree consolidate marks memo for 3 year LLB course and Provisional Certificate (PC) / Original Degree (OD).
5. Transfer Certificate.
6. Study Certificate giving the details of past seven years of study from 1st appearance of qualifying exam.
7. Residence Certificate for preceding seven (7) years of the qualifying examination.
8. Latest Income Certificate / White Ration card, issued by the competent authority (MRO/ Tahsildar) containing the name of the candidate
9. Aadhar Card or any Govt. ID (PAN / DRIVING LICENCE)
10. Caste Certificate, etc., issued by competent authority (MRO / Tahsildar) containing the name of the candidate.
11. Minority Certificate (SSC TC containing Minority Status or Certificate from the Head Master).
12. EWS Certificate valid for the year 2024-25 from Mee Seva/ **Gram Sachivalayam** for OC candidates who want to claim reservation under EWS category, if applicable.

Note: The candidates who are admitted under self-support category are not eligible for Government scholarships.

Fee to be paid: (at the time of Registration):

- 1) The Qualified and eligible Candidates of APLAWCET/PGLCET-2024 who have participated in first phase Counseling need not pay the processing fee once again. These candidates are informed to exercise their options afresh for the leftover seats now available and consequential vacancies that may arise in the process of allotment, additional seats available in new colleges/courses.
- 2) Non-refundable Processing **Fee Rs.500/- (SC/ST/PH) and others Rs.1000/-**. Through payment gateway (Bill desk) provided in the website <https://cets.apsche.ap.gov.in> by entering hall ticket number and rank/Date of Birth from **14-11-2024 to 17-11-2024** using credit/debit card/net banking/other channels.
- 3) The candidates who have not participated in first phase are directed to get their certificates verified in this final phase as per the schedule given below.
- 4) Candidates who have already attended for Online Certificate verification in First Phase can directly exercise web options for second phase of counselling as per the schedule.**
- 5) All the candidates who are eligible for second phase are informed to register online and furnish the required information in the application form. All the entries should be correct and the candidate is solely responsible for any incorrect entry.**

- 6) Tuition Fee particulars and seats available under Convener Quota College wise will be made available on the website <https://cets.apsche.ap.gov.in> before the commencement of Option Entry.
- 7) The fee reimbursement for eligible candidates is subject to the guidelines issued by the Government from time to time.
- 8) Who should participate in Phase-II
 - a. Who secured a seat in Phase-I of web-based counselling and wish to move to some other college.
 - b. Candidates who participated in Phase-I of web-based counselling and could not secure a seat.
 - c. Candidates who did not participate in Phase-I.
 - d. Candidates who were allotted a seat but didn't report.
 - e. A candidate allotted a seat in Phase-I but cancelled his / her admission.

- 9) The candidates may note that,
- Options exercised for first phase will not be considered for second phase of counselling.
 - Candidates have to exercise options fresh option for each phase of web-based counselling.
 - In case, if they are satisfied with the previous allotment and joined a college, options need not be exercised again.
 - Options may be exercised for those colleges even if the vacancies are not available, as vacancies may arise due to sliding, cancellation and conversions.
- 10) If the candidate secures a seat in Phase-II, seat allotted to him/ her in the Phase-I stands cancelled automatically and has to report to the new college by downloading the allotment letter on or before the date furnished in the allotment letter. Failing to self report and reporting to the college within the date furnished in the allotted college, the candidate will forfeit the claim on the new college as well as in the old college.

Note:

- (a) Eligibility for Admission into 3 year LLB course: The candidate for 3 year LLB course should have passed Graduation Degree 10+2+3 pattern (Regular/Distance/Open/Correspondence) from any recognized university of India or outside or equivalent.

Note: The candidates who have passed Degree examination by single sitting without undergoing three years course either through regular or private or correspondence or Distance and those who obtained the degree through open University directly without having any basic qualification are not eligible.

(b) Eligibility for Admission into 5 year LLB course: the candidate should have passed two year Intermediate Examination with 10+2 pattern (such as 11+1), 'A' level in Senior School Leaving certificate course from a recognized university of India or outside or equivalent.

Note: The applicants who have obtained 10+2 or graduation /post-graduation through open Universities system directly without having any basic qualification (i.e SSC) for prosecuting such studies are not eligible for admission into law courses.

- Mere allotment of a seat through the admission counselling will not guarantee the admission to the candidate unless he /she satisfies the eligibility criteria for admission as per the Bar Council of India Rules notified time to time.

3. Candidates who are allotted seats in a particular college shall submit original certificates in the college for physical verification. Principal of the college shall also be responsible for verification of the eligibility of the candidate for admission. Final allotment of seat for admission is subject to satisfactory verification of all original certificates at allotted college.
4. Tuition fee, if payable shall be paid by the candidate at the college.
